Summer league will end on Sunday, September 9th and all winners will be posted on the board – please check to see if you or your team are tied for any awards. Shoot offs can be shot on September 30th by noon at no charge – you can shoot off prior at your cost but please make sure the league representative is aware that it is your shoot off round.

The Annual Meeting, Membership Shoot and League Shoot Offs will be held on Sunday Sept 30th. The Membership Shoot is open to all club members and is your chance to have some fun shooting the unpredictable international targets! You can shoot any or all of the events. There will be an assortment of door prizes drawn throughout the day. The Annual Meeting will be held at 1 pm and power to the traps will be shut off so everyone can attend. A signup sheet for available Board positions is posted at the club. Please help keep the club running by attending the meeting!

Fall League starts on Tuesday September 11th and will continue for 6 weeks. The league is an individual competition and consists of 6 rounds of singles and handicap to be shot by the end of league. The league fee is \$5 and the fees will be paid back to the winners on a Lewis basis.

Have you shot on our new trap fields yet? Traps 3 and 4 have new wider pathways that are handicap accessible. Many thanks to the board members and volunteers that helped with this project.

Derby Shoots start Oct 21st and continue over the winter. Derby's are open to all shooters and include 1 round of singles and 1 round of handicap. Prize money is paid

back to the shooters on a lewis basis with a % of the prize money going towards the jackpot. If a shooter wins 3 derby's in the year they win the jackpot -if not it carries over to the next year. The starting jackpot for 2018 is \$2,475.

Our 42nd Annual July \$1,000 shoot was another success – Congratulations to Elizabeth Birchfield for winning both the Handicap Event and the High Overall for the weekend. A total of 118 shooters participated in the Handicap event this year with excellent shooting results.

September is here and hours are changing – we are open at 5 on Tuesdays, closed Thursdays and normal hours on Sunday.
